Program Overview

The College of Education's Executive Educator program is one of the major outreach venues for teachers, administrators, and other educational professionals. The program is intended to reflect the need for training and technical assistance at the state, district, and school levels as part of a comprehensive system of personal and professional development. The program integrates traditional university instructional models with a dynamic market driven model, to better serve our colleagues and Louisiana's students and families.

Services Offered

Option 1: Monthly sessions will be offered on the campus of LSU (see schedule on following page). As the program expands, the topics will as well. All sessions will occur at LSU and will be held from 8:30-3:30.

Option 2: On-site services within your own district or school can be utilized and tailored to meet individual needs. Services include facilitating, meeting/planning, training, evaluating and can cover a wide array of topics related to behavioral support. Interested districts/schools must complete a professional service contract with LSU for services.

Cost of Services

Option 1:

LSU Sessions Per Person:

*1 Day Training: \$100

*2 Day Training: \$175

*3 Day Training: \$250

-Cost includes light lunch, materials, parking, and trainer fees.

Option 2:

A. On-Site Training Services:

Length of Time	Expense Per Day
1-3 Days	\$1800/day
4-6 Days	\$1600/day
7 or more days	\$1400/day

*NOTE: Expense per day only covers trainer fee(s) and travel.

B. On-Site District Subscription:

A subscription service includes training as well as planning, evaluation, and the use of outcome data to make decisions. Subscriptions must be a minimum of 7 service days. Cost for a subscription = \$1000/day which will cover trainer fee(s) and travel.

No one can attend a session unless payment has been received and you have received email confirmation.
